you can do with word cards:

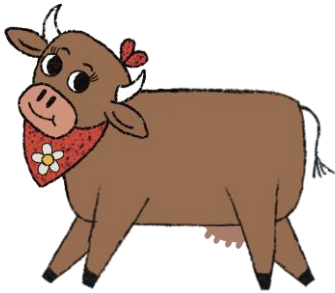
- *Students can use magnet letters to build the words

Lastly, they use a dry erase marker to WRITE the word in the bottom box.

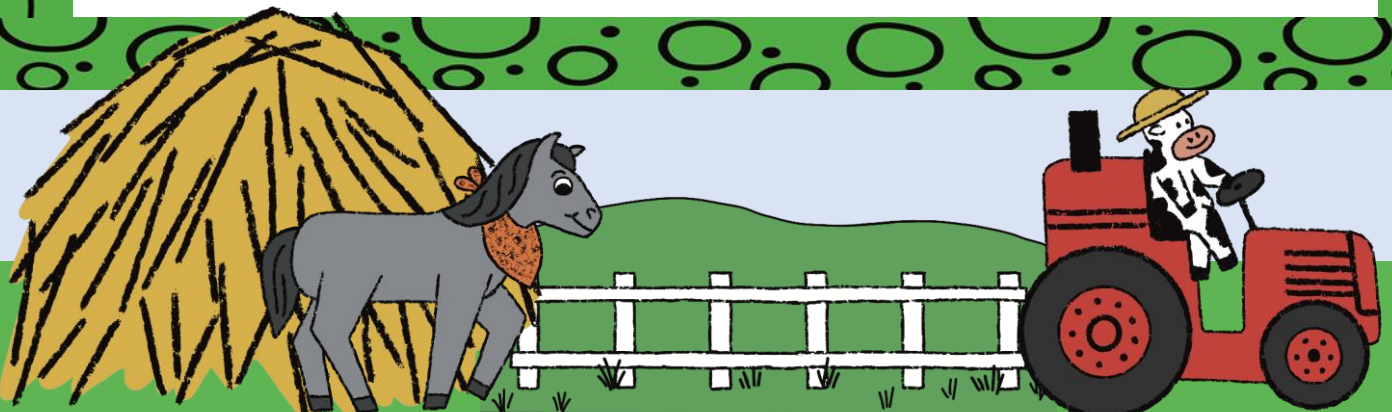

The Happy Happy Cow

How Many Are In The Truck?

You pick the number you want students to decompose (up to 10 per sheet). For example, if you want students to practice decomposing the number 7, only put out 7 ice cream cones.

Laminate the board and the game pieces. Cut out the game pieces.

How to Play

1. Player 1 closes their eyes while Player 2 hides some/none of the ice cream cones behind the food truck, and places the remaining pieces on the board.
2. Player 1 opens their eyes and guesses how many ice cream cones are "hiding" in the truck. (Player 1 has to count how many they see, and subtract that number from the total number in the set.)
3. Both players look under the food truck to see how many were "hiding" inside.
4. Play again! Students take turns being Players 1 and 2.

Players can use the recording sheet to keep track of how many were hiding or not hiding.

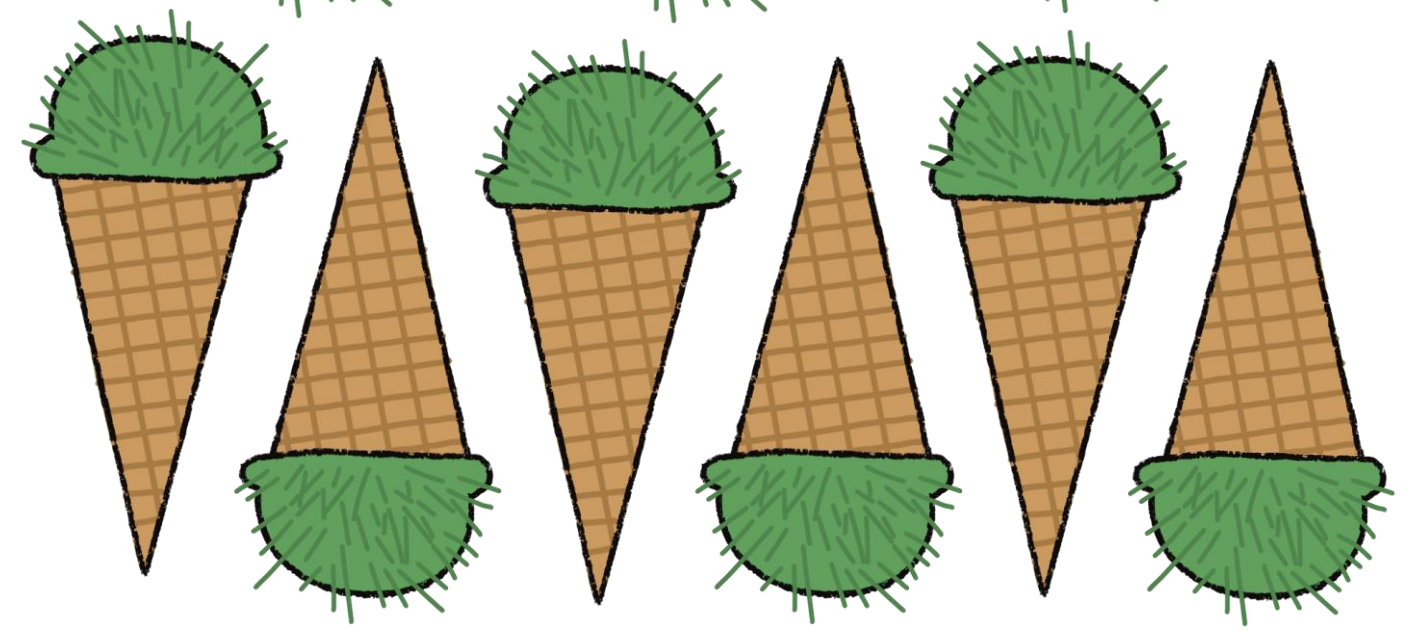
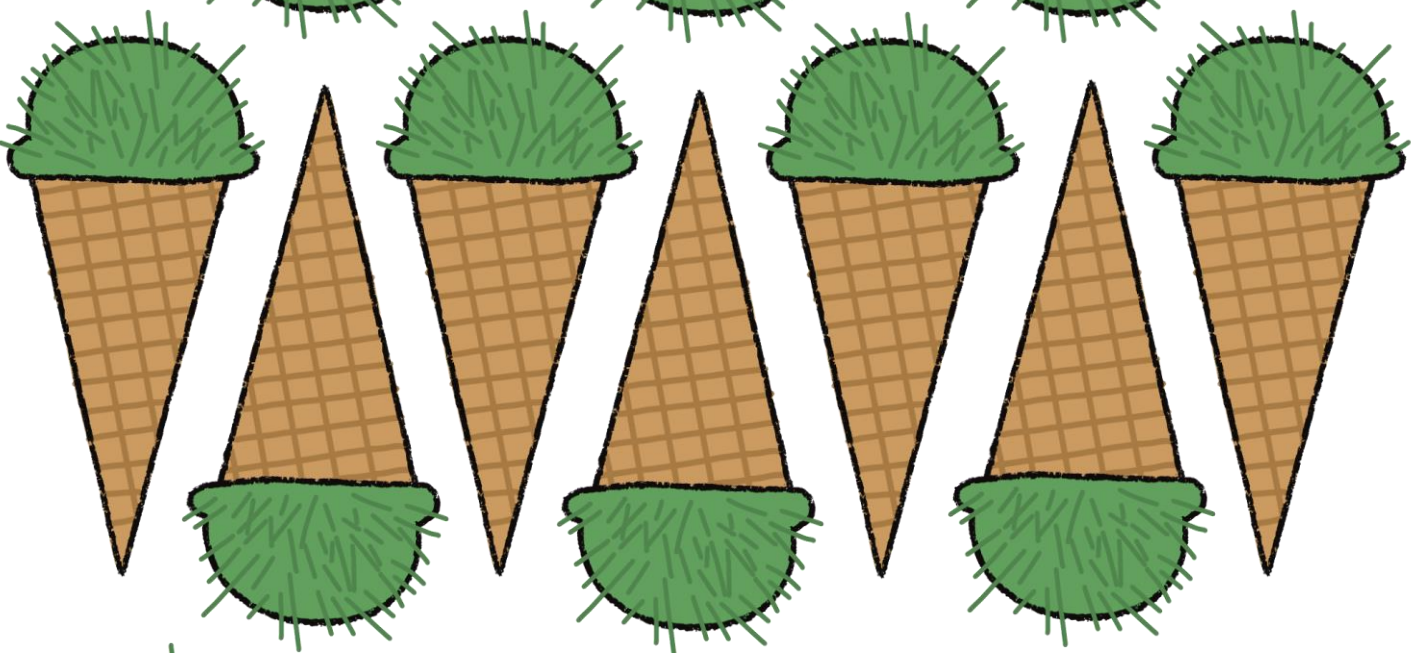
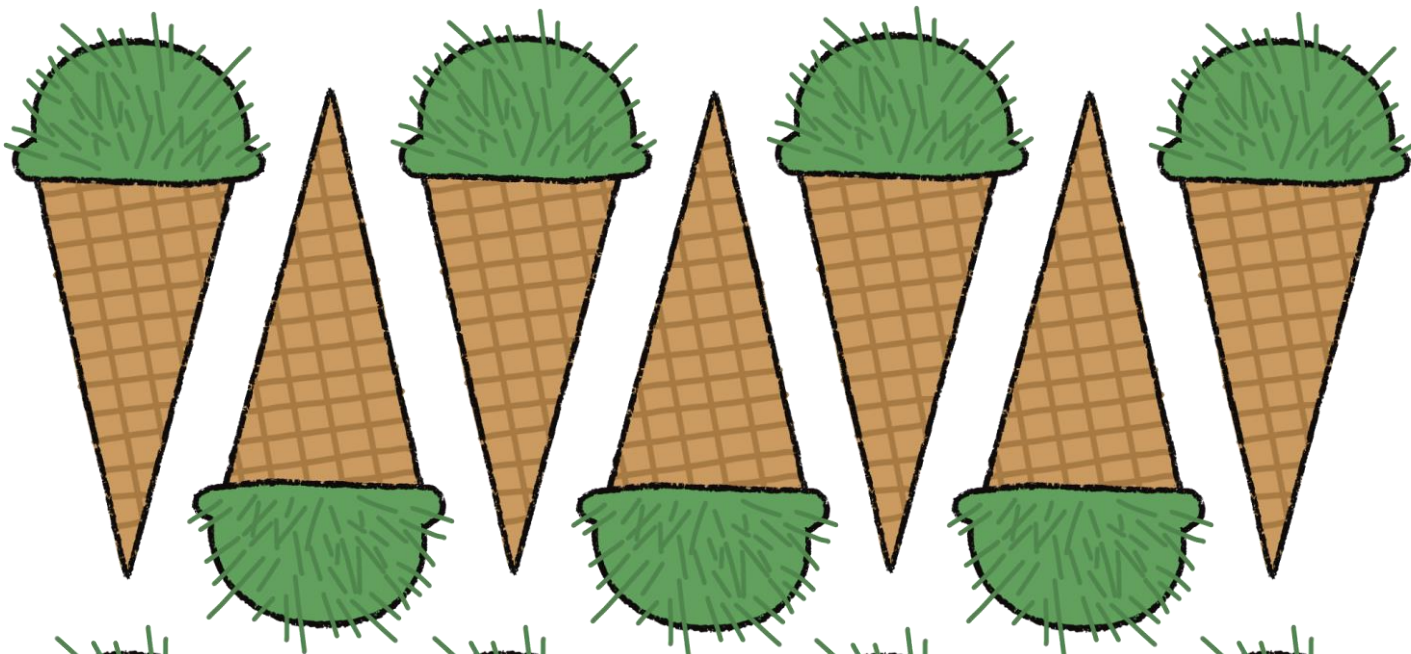

Copy the boards. Children may use dot markers or crayons to play these games. You will need 1 or 2 dice. These games can be played alone or with a friend.

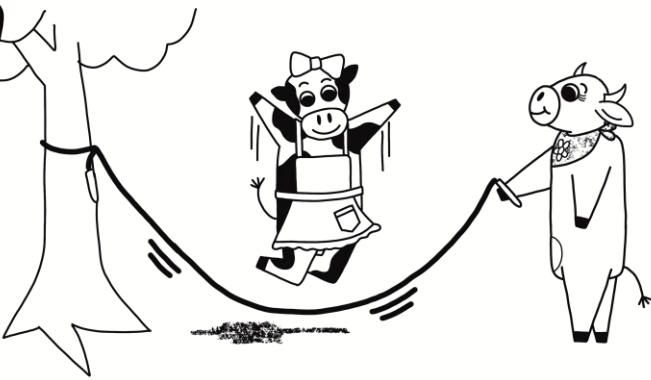
How to Play:

Counting: Use 1 dice. Student rolls the dice, counts the dots, and colors in that many squares on their board.

Adding: Use 2 dice. Student rolls both dice, and adds together all the dots. Color in that number of squares on their board.

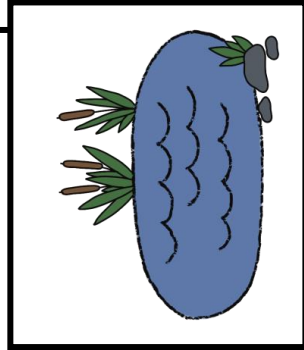
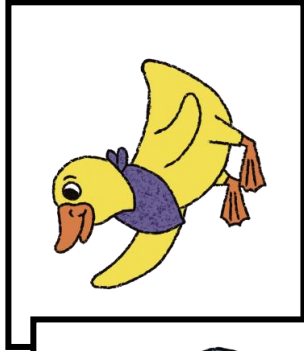
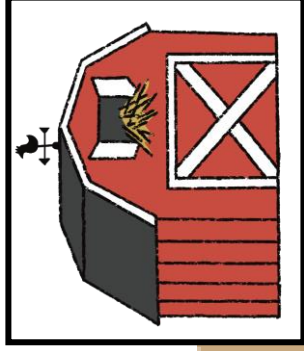
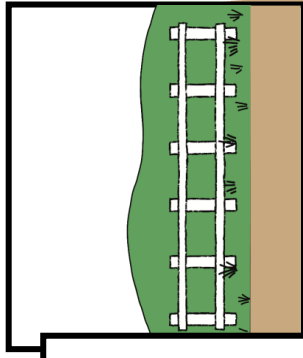
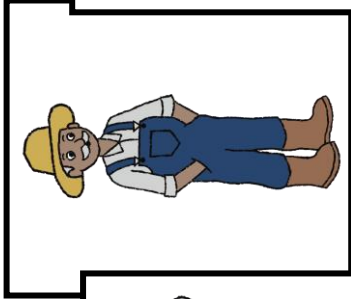
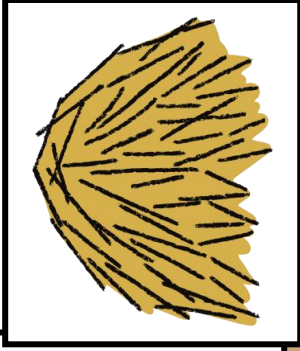
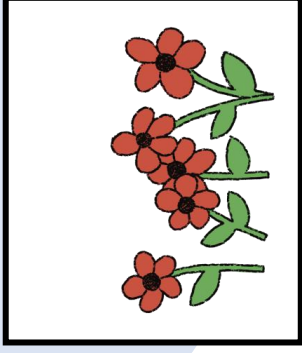
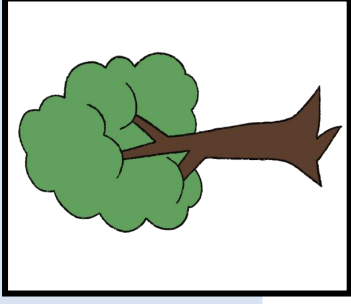
1. Students choose several flash cards, and create matching scenes using the small colored items and laminated blank farm scene. Play over and over using different flash cards each time.

3. Students color and cut the small blank images of "Things On A Farm". They paste these images to the blank worksheet to create their Farm Scene.



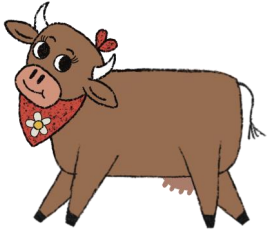

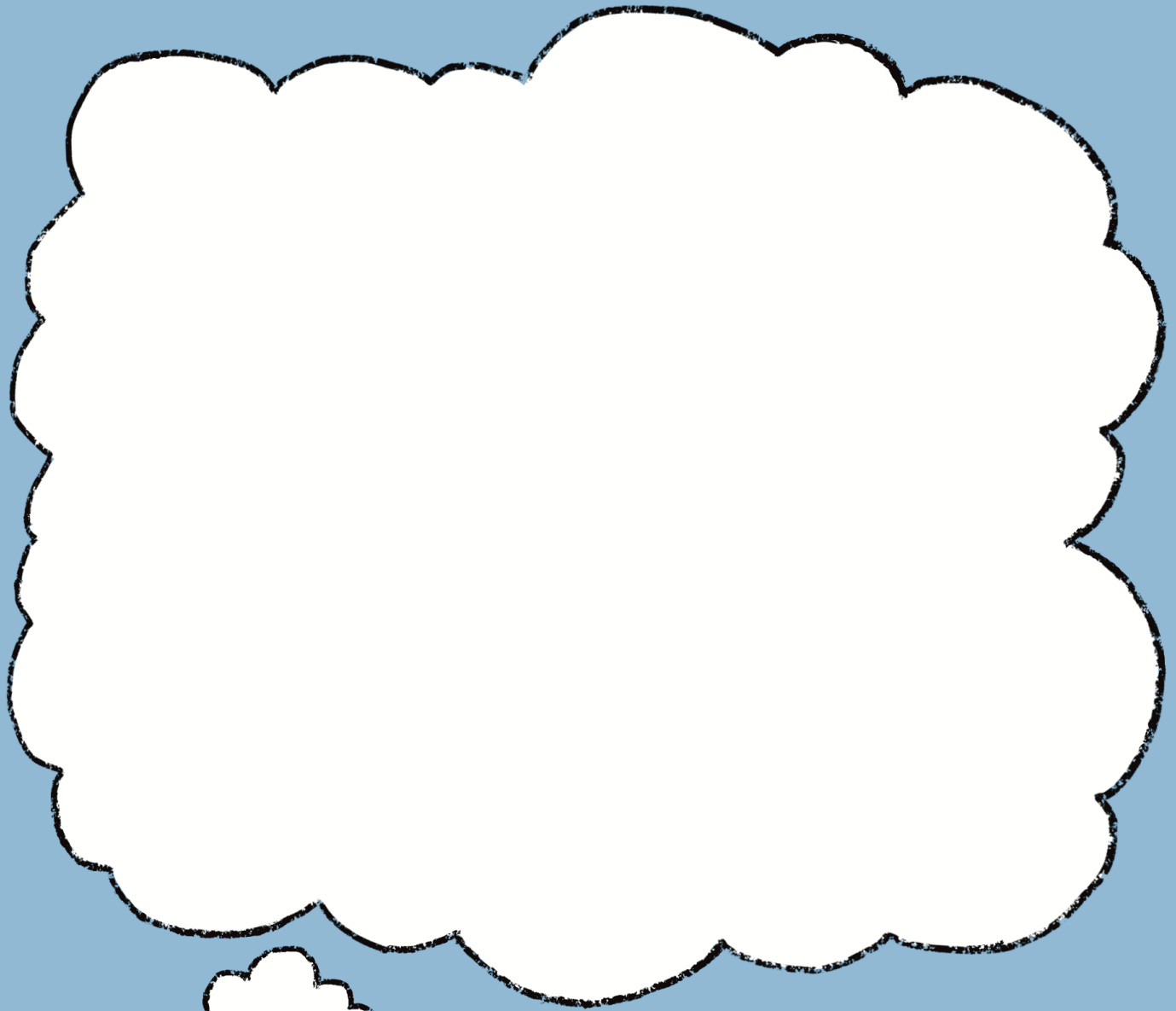
How to Play:

2. Use the page as a play dough mat. Students can sculpt things that make them feel happy.

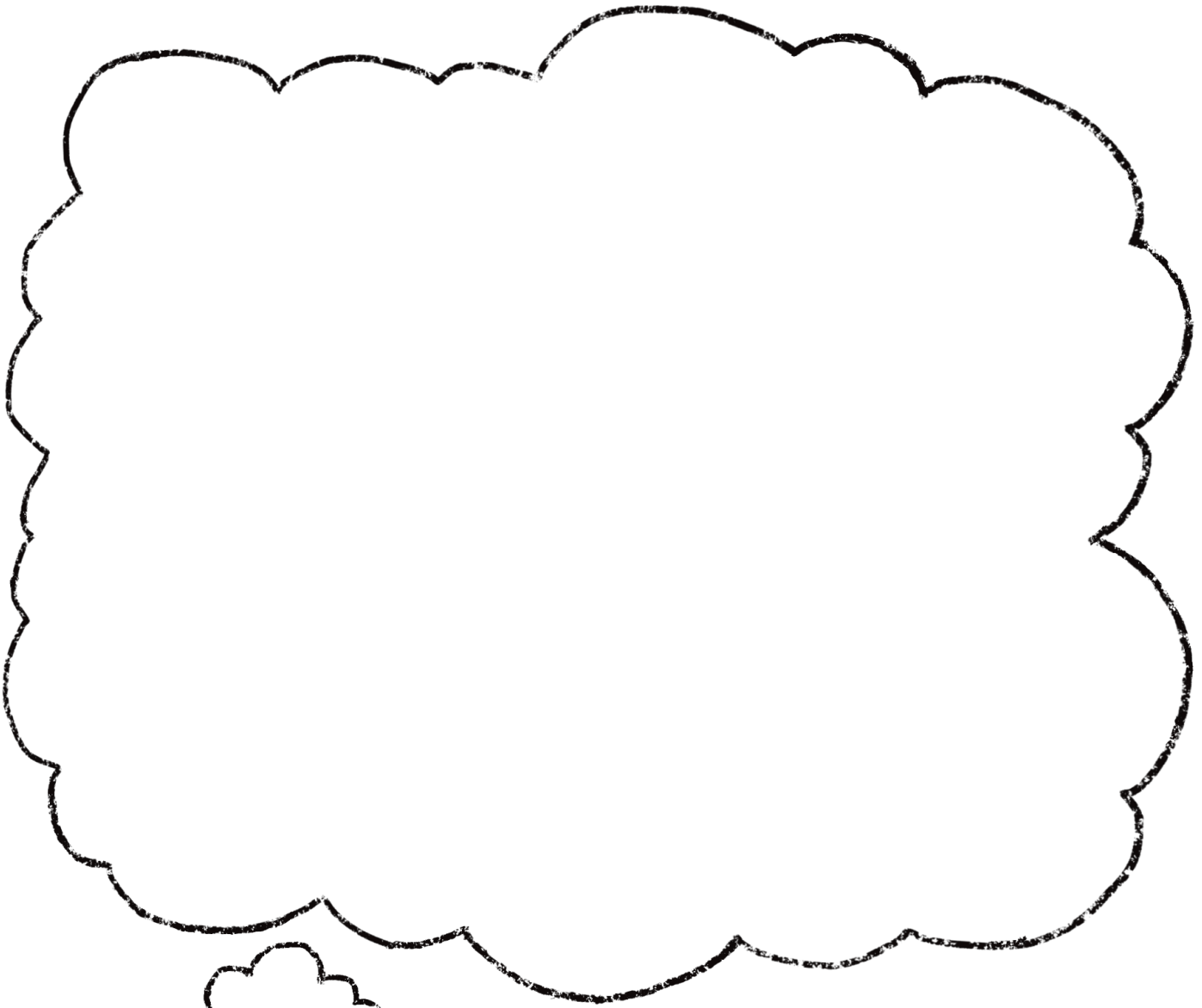
Make copies of the blank worksheet. Students may draw a picture of something that makes them feel happy, and then show-and-tell their picture to the rest of the class.

The Happy Happy "SHAPES" Cow

Students recognize shapes, and use them to create their own Happy-Happy Cow.

This activity uses fine motor skills with positioning, cutting, and gluing the pieces.

1. Use the worksheets to practice tracing shapes.
2. Follow the instructions to use shapes to make a Happy Happy Cow.

You will need:

Sturdy cardstock (to make color copies)

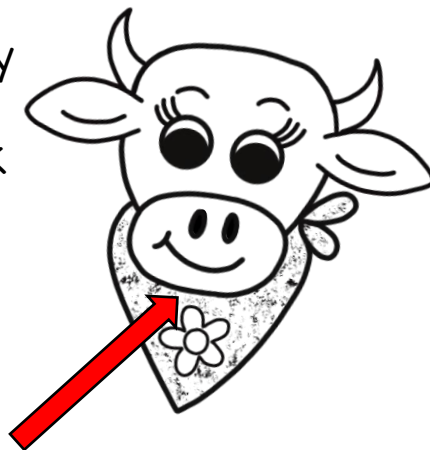
Scissors

Glue

Black crayons

For each student, use sturdy cardstock to make color copies of the two pages with pattern pieces. Cut out the pieces ahead of time, or instruct the students to cut out the pieces.

Once the cow is completely assembled, instruct the students to use the black crayon to create a nose and mouth for the Happy Happy Cow!



INSTRUCTIONS:

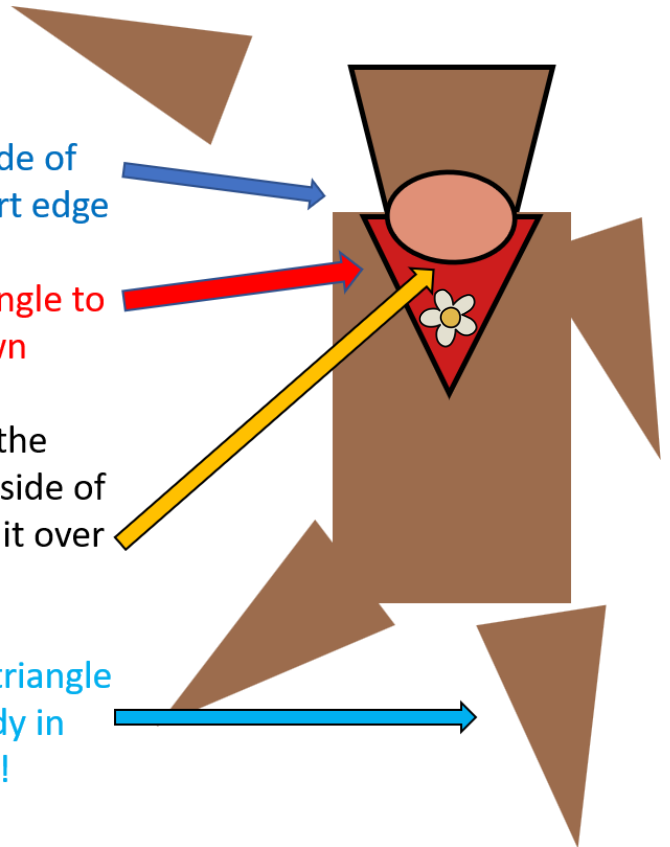
PHASE ONE:

Step 1: Glue the short side of the trapezoid to the short edge of the rectangle.

Step 2: Glue the red triangle to a short edge of the brown rectangle.

Step 3: Center and glue the pink oval over the short side of the rectangle, centering it over the red triangle and the trapezoid.

Step 4: Glue the brown triangle legs and arms to the body in any position you choose!



PHASE TWO:

1: Instruct the student to cut apart the horns.

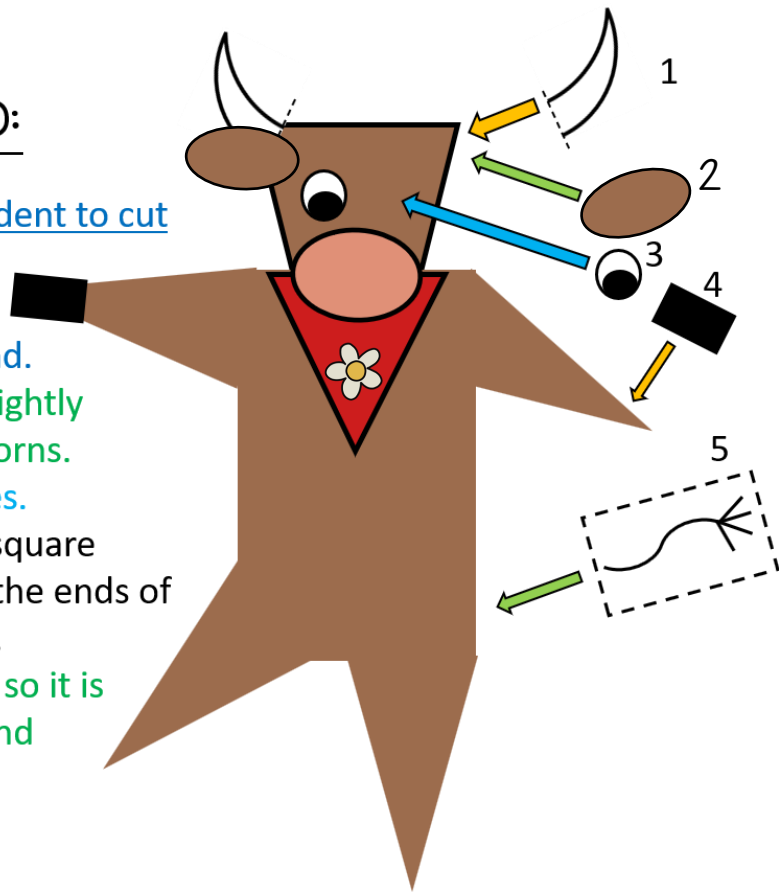
Glue to the corners of the head.

2: Glue the ears slightly overlapping the horns.

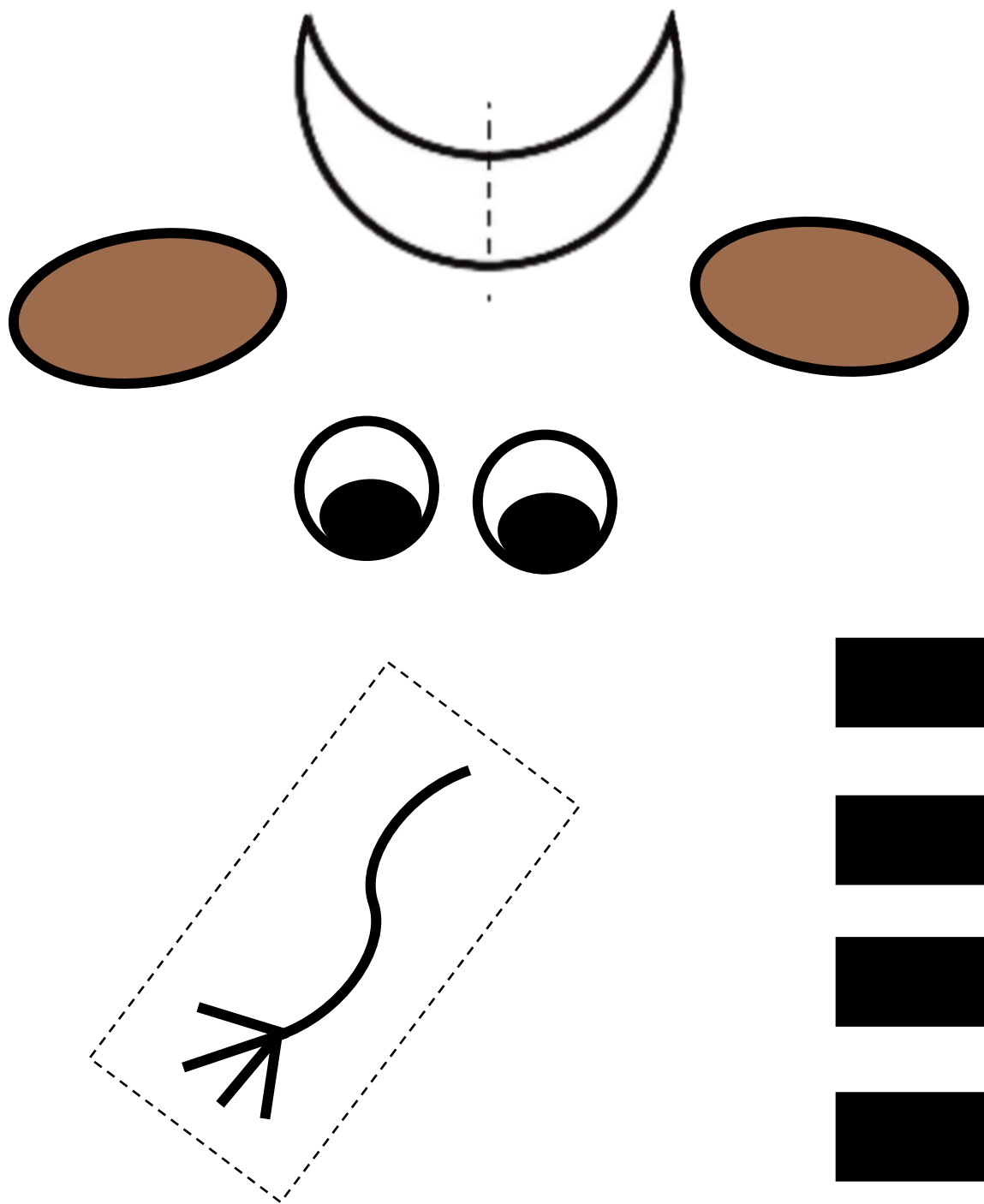

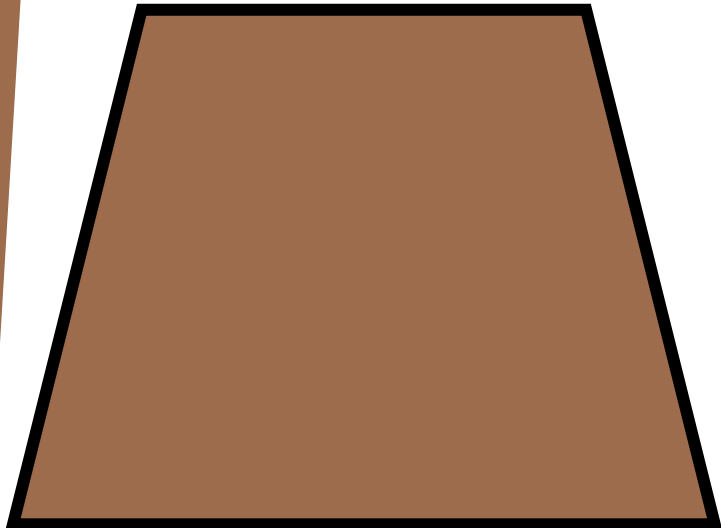
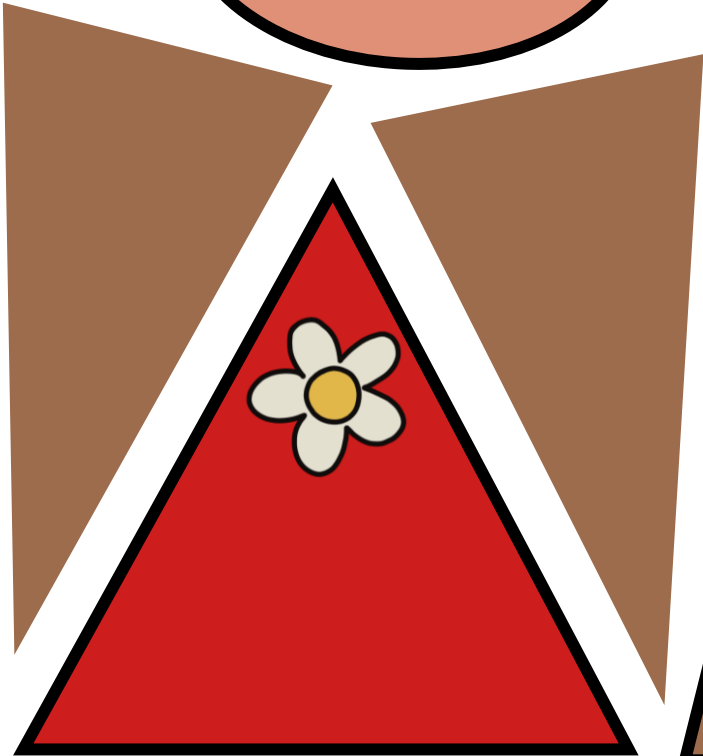
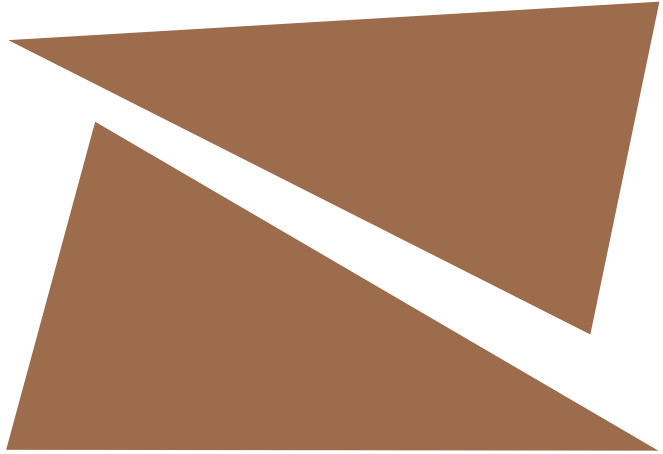
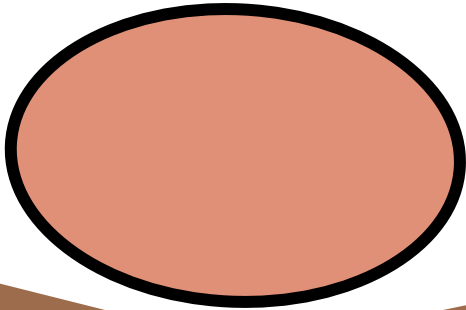
4: Glue the black square rectangle feet on the ends of the arms and legs.
